

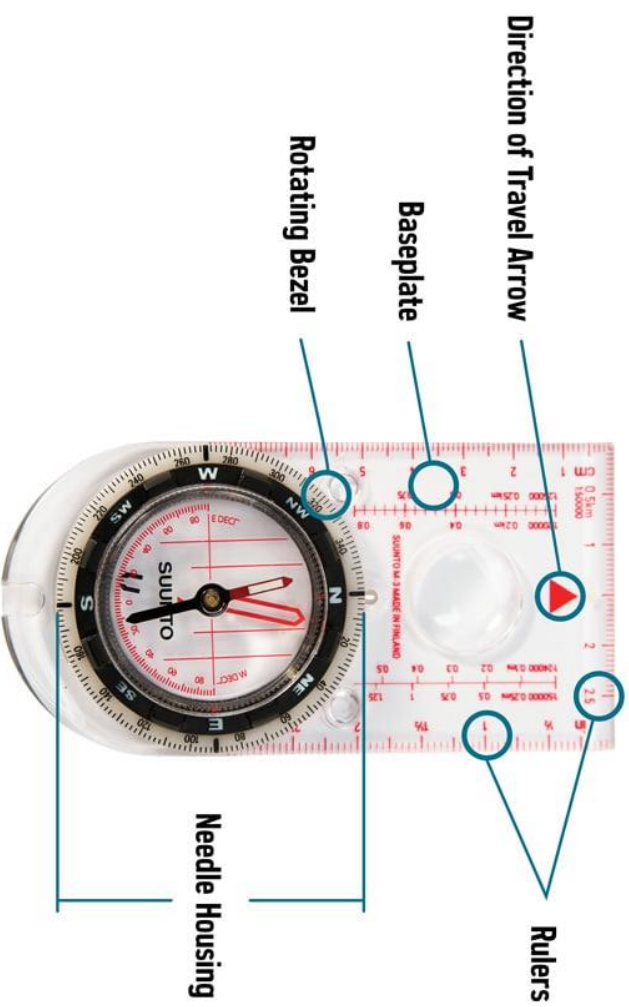
Compass Course Challenge at Montbello Branch

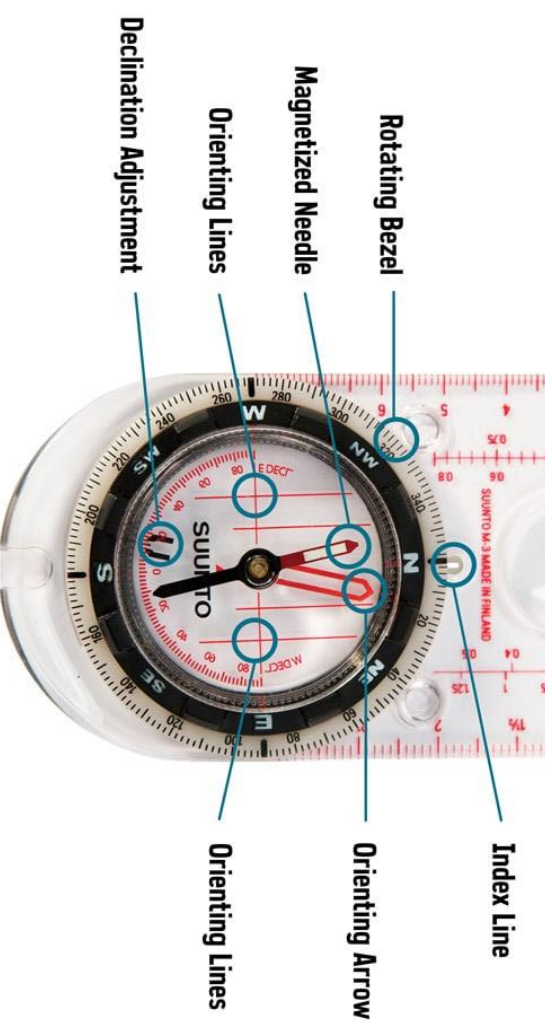
You will be provided a compass that you get to keep. Inside this brochure you'll find a map with instructions.

Montbello Branch Compass Course #1



1. Begin at the front desk under the sign that says "Information". Stand with your back to the desk, facing the children's area.
2. You will take a bearing of 309° NW. To get to your destination you will take 20 steps. What are some animals that you see?
3. From here you will take a bearing of 210° SW. Take 14 steps, then look up, what character do you see?
4. Next you will set your bearing to 139° SE. Take 23 steps, what did you find?
5. Now you are ready to explore outside! Ask us for compass course #2.
