

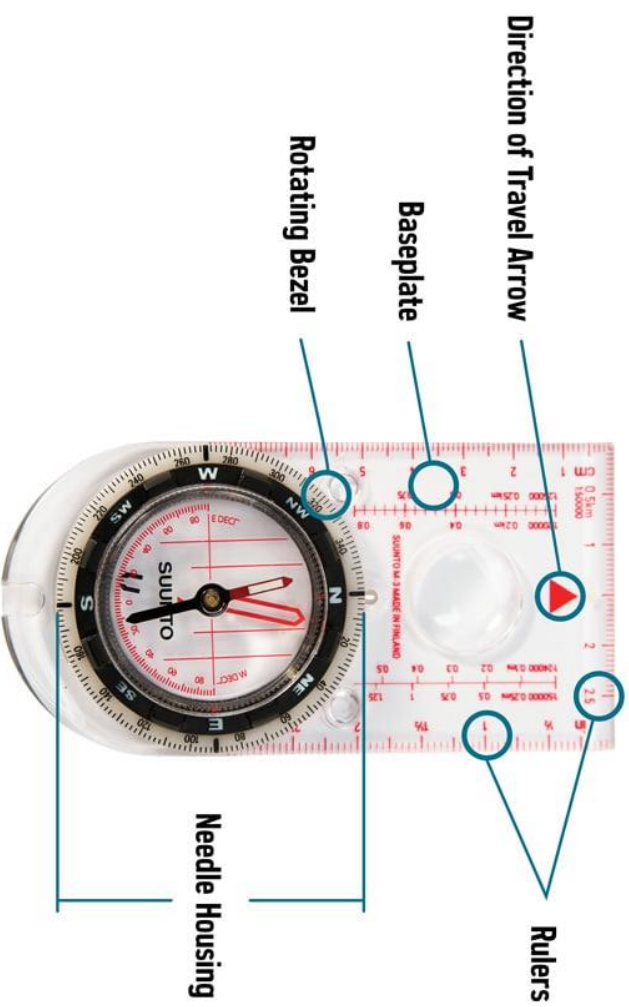
Compass Course Challenge at Montbello Branch

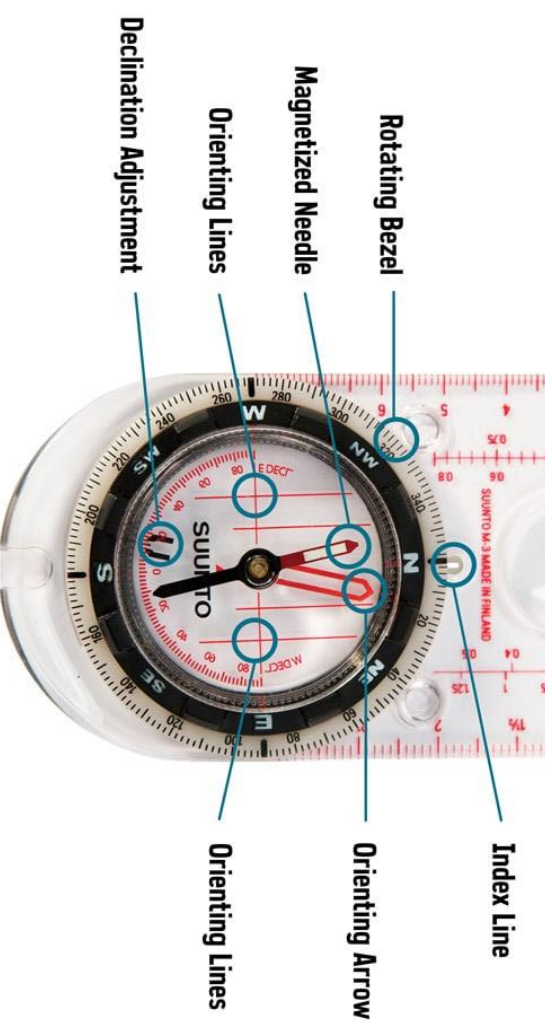
You will be provided a compass that you get to keep. Inside this brochure you'll find a map with instructions.

1. Go out the front door and begin at the sculpture to the left. Set your bearing to 133° SE. Take 12 steps and look down, what word do you see? _____
2. You will take a bearing of 70° NE. Please watch for cars and then take 53 steps and look for the purple letter.
Write the letters you find in the space next to each clue. _____
3. Next, take a bearing of 0° N. Take 70 steps, then you will have to look hard to find the red letter. _____
4. Now set your bearing to 139° SE. Take 50 steps and look for the orange letter. _____
5. The next bearing will be 346° NW. Take 50 steps to get there and look for the pink letter. _____
6. For the final letter, take a bearing of 82° NE, take 27 steps and find the yellow letter. _____
7. Unscramble the letters to make a word. What does it spell? _____

Hint: It is something you find at the library.
