If you enjoy exploring new places and appreciate games with clues, you'll want to participate in this Scavenger Hunt Challenge.

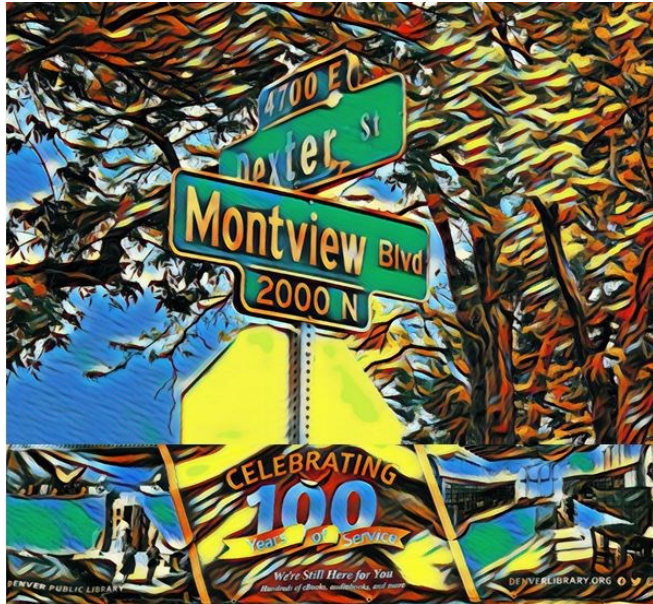
Complete any of the scavenger hunt challenges at participating branch locations and pick up this limited edition coin.

Write the answer:



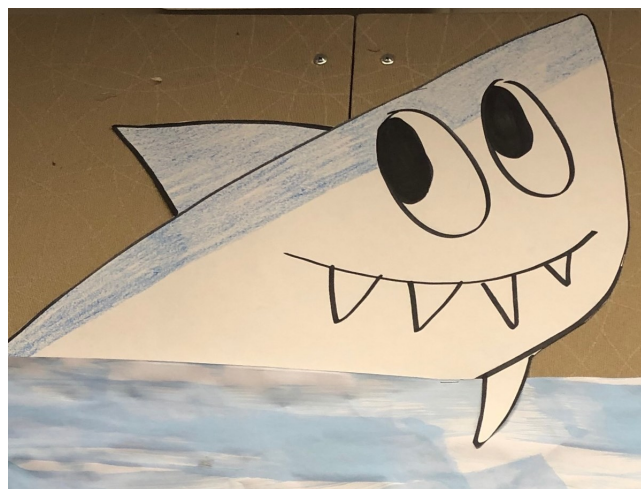
2) Go up the slope and turn, at a corner you will find a quote from Cicero. Do you have everything you need? Write the answer:
