

Compass Course Challenge at Valdez-Perry

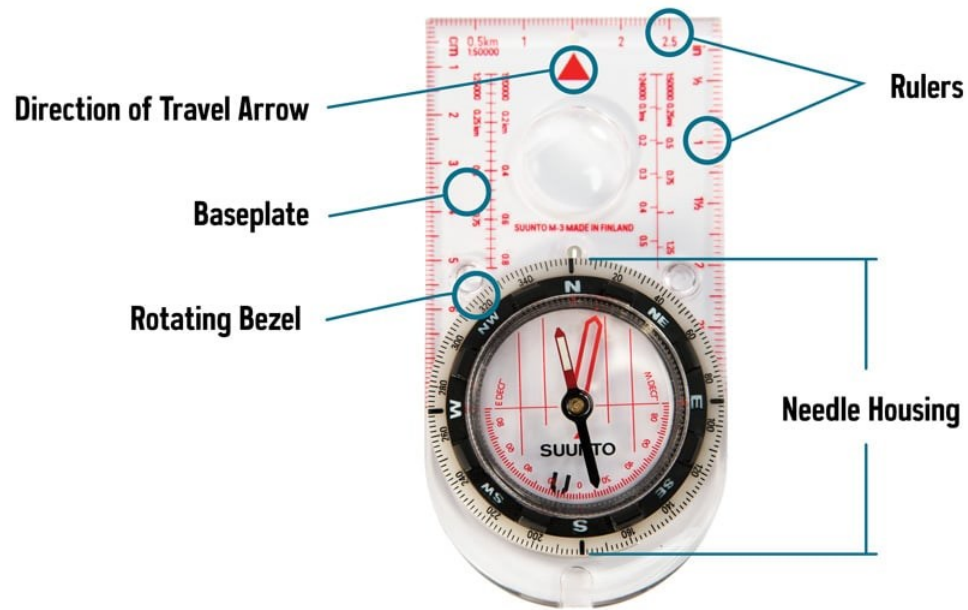

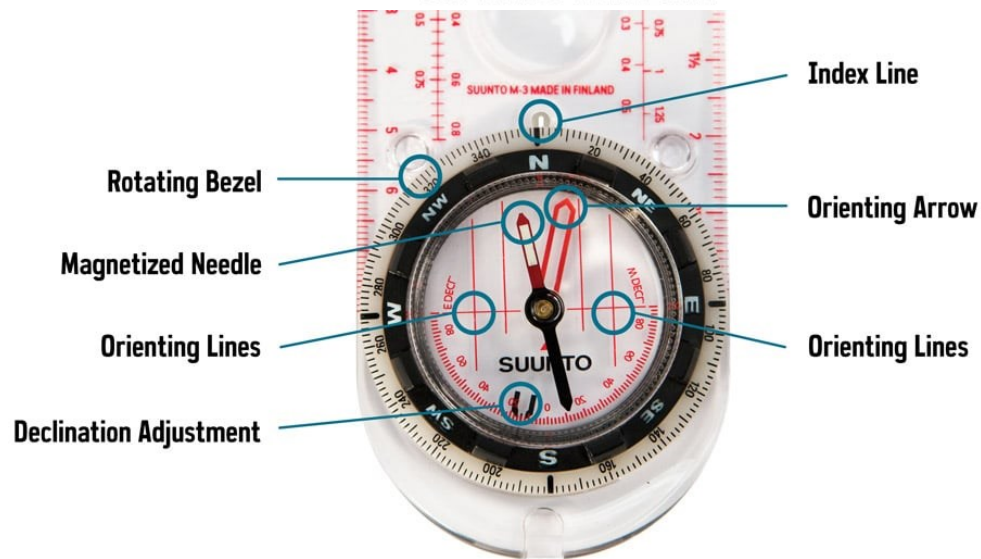
You will be provided a compass that you get to keep. Inside this brochure you'll find a map with instructions.

NEEDLE HOUSING DETAIL

Step 1:

Start at the front doors inside of the Valdez-Perry Branch Library. Hop to the floor square with the yellow dot landmark on it! Face your body East (hint: the carpet in front of you leads you). Take 10 steps forward.

Step 2:

Face your body North (hint: North is left of East on the compass). Take 5 steps forward. Turn your body 90 degrees East and take 13 carpet squares forward. What color carpet square did you land on?

Step 3:

Now, spin to the right 270 degrees (hint: face North). Walk 10 carpet squares forward, STOP, and look at your compass.

Step 4:

What animal(s) do you see at the "E" (East) on your compass? (hint: above orange square)
