How many did you find?



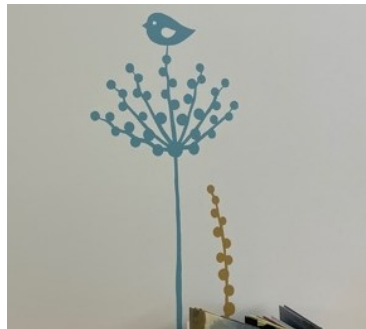
Find this chair, which is not a great seat, with an apple nearby that you cannot eat. Write down the name of a book on the table, and something you see in the painting - if you are able
